After dropping Fetig off two hours outside of town (giving him a full day's walk back) I pushed the chair to full speed and we put in a half day of travel. Before stopping for camp, around 16:00 we came across two humanoids on the side of the road with a crude sign written in Common, Orcish, and Dwarven stating "LemOnAid 4 SaLE". The party decided they weren't interested in lemonade so I pushed on. Arco told me after we set up camp at 21:00 that he was pretty certain those two humanoids were child giants. Considering their voices sounded childlike to all of us when we passed and they called out in common, mixed with their heights being that of an adult human, I'm glad we kept moving.

Around 03:00 of the 10th of Jularva as Azura and I were on watch I noticed something moving out in the grass to the North of our camp; and as soon as I did Azura's dragon plate roared and woke the party. I noticed the things moving towards us were giant spiders and called out that fact to everyone else. Arco raised his arm and a massive fireball exploded in the middle of the group which allowed us all to see them for what they really were. Desert tarantulas. The last time we faced them we found out how hard they were to kill, and it seems we were going to have a second shot. As the fireball lit up the night Scott sat up and launched his Javelin of Chain Lightning. As soon as the fireball died down the chain lightning started up and ricocheted between the tarantulas and two of them dropped. We were still left with seven tarantulas to face but that didn't stop Arco from yelling out to Scott "That was an amazing light show!" We started facing off with them in melee combat as they rushed us and slowly we started whittling them down while they took big chunks out of us and Harka hid beneath the cart.

Julianne rushed in to help beat on one of the spiders and bring it down as Arco launched a lightning bolt towards four of the tarantulas. As soon as he did Bamf! And the tarantulas had teleported out of the range of the lightning bolt. I found one behind me, Scott had one land on him, Arco likewise found himself with a shadow and the last tarantula appeared in the rocks to the south of us and scampered off into the darkness. My shadow knocked me down and took a big bite out of me. 05:00 on the 10th of Jularva everyone went through their morning rutines and Arco requested the party wait an extra hour while he tried to collect the venom from the tarantula corpses we had. At the end of that hour I noticed Arco vomiting and staggering around. I turned to Scott and asked if Arco normally vomits after dealing with bodies and we all went over to figure out how he got poisoned and what the effects were. Azura figured out that Arco had 12 hours to live. Enola came forward and tagged Arco with a Resist Poison spell, and prepared her second spell for a noon hit, extending Arco's hourglass to 22 hours. The party finished loading up into the cart and Azura was saddled to the stool. The plan became push through to town by 11pm instead of heading back to Parlonis and convince a

priest to see us before Arco dies at dawn.

At 09:00 the cart rolled up to a dry gulch with a small bridge over it and a wooden bar painted red and white barricading the way. A Half-Elven man wearing a poufy shirt, shiny black boots, and a feathered hat jumped out from behind a rock on the other side of the gulch and cried "A-hah! Stop! Who goes there! Stop I say!" Hoo cried out "Keep going, we don't have time for this, he'll move!" but Azura pulled the cart to a stop at the edge of the bridge, not wanting to take a wooden beam to his face and risk getting knocked over. The party was stunned and in the commotion after the un-provoked attack on the man who had surrendered to us we just decided to move on with the vague warning that there was something dangerous between us and town. Another few hours later, as Arco was approaching the time where he would need another hit from Enola the party came upon the afore-warned danger and Azura's chest roared.
